### Community Garden

Mr. Plambeck reported that the trees and hangers have been cleared at Woodland Park. The Township Committee is requesting more information on certain aspects.

### Green Initiatives

Mrs. Steffens was not present. A number of Commissioners had worked on the rain garden at Memorial Park.

Mr. DiFiglia reviewed the changes made for the Green Initiatives web site. Mr. DiFiglia and Ms. Murphy will work on revising the Environmental Commission's web site.

On other matters, Mr. Tancredi discussed a Sustainable Jersey \$2,000 grant that is available. This is a capacity building grant to support valuable sustainability related activities in the Borough of Chatham, including the anti-idling program. Mr. Tancredi noted that Mrs. Steffens is asking the Commission to pass a resolution in support of the two grants – one for the electric vehicle charging station and the capacity building grant. Mr. Plambeck read aloud the resolution. Mr. Plambeck made a motion to approve this resolution supporting the capacity building grant and the anti-idling program. Ms. Thuebel seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken. The resolution was unanimously approved by all Commissioners present. Mr. Tancredi signed the resolution. A copy of the resolution will be e-mailed to Mrs. Steffens and Janice Piccolo.

Mr. DiFiglia noted that the next avenue for extension Sustainable Jersey will be for the schools. Later this month, Mr. DiFiglia will be attending a seminar on school projects. He will report back to the Commission.

The Explore Chatham Photo Contest

Mr. Plambeck reported that all openings for judges have been filled. Mr. Plambeck and Mr. Britt are currently looking for contestant prizes from local merchants.

Mr. Plambeck also reported that Borough interns Andrew Holloway and Charles Ross have completed their report on the Loop Trail which will involve both Chatham and Summit. A grant is being pursued on this matter. Equinox in Summit is interested in possibly creating a trail behind their building.
