In 2014, the Building Department was extremely busy. Although, the permits declined by 56.4% the number of inspections remained largely unchanged (.7% decrease). Our fees collected decreased by 25.4%. The change is due to larger projects being initiated, where in the past few years the projects were smaller in size and scope.

The fees continue to be collected by Madison for all UCC permits.

The Borough has retained all CCO inspections, tree inspections and non-UCC permit applications along with their respective fees.

We look forward to another busy year, while coordinating all activities with Madison personnel.
