Goals & Accomplishments:

Identify areas of need for beautification and utilize Public Private Partnerships to make public space improvements. Adopt a philosophy that more hands make lighter work, while evoking community pride in residents, commercial property owners and business owners. Organize an annual Spring Clean Up after long difficult winters.

Act as a catalyst volunteer group to beautify the commercial corridor during all seasons including the holidays. The Committee launched *Bring Back the White Lights* a tradition during the Christmas season along Main Street through donated funds. Assist with Santa's visit to town, and a community tree lighting ceremony. Decorate Reasoner Park and the Gazebo for the holidays with the assistance of Public Works; a former Chamber of Commerce activity. Maintain the Central Business District planters.

Transform community pocket parks into community gathering spaces of character and beauty.

In 2013 the War Memorial in front of the Library was completed. Bicentennial Park at the head of Fairmount Avenue on Main Street was upgraded in 2014. Both projects mobilized hundreds of volunteers and thousands of donated dollars. The Department of Public Works played a major role not only with annual focus projects, but with over 30 other sites weeded, mulched and litter patrolled during a five hour clean up performed by volunteers of all ages.

Working with local businesses, partnering with Macy's Department store, running youth t-shirt art contest, and soliciting residents through two direct to home mailings produced the funds required to complete all of the above without tax generated monies.






