

The Transfer Station owner has been very cooperative with Chatham Borough Officials and will be removing any stockpile of leaves by January 12, 2016. The Transfer Station which is required to control any odors by NJ Department of Environmental Protection, may have used a deodorizer in the past, but the odor residents are experiencing is that of decaying leaves due to the unseasonably warm temperatures we have experienced so far this winter, not any chemical application applied to the decaying leaves.
