Join the Chatham Borough Municipal Pool - be part of the action, see the renovations unfold - view the upcoming facility plan for the site including the new wading pool.

The Chatham Boro Municipal Pool will open weekends, beginning May 28th. The pool will open for its full-time schedule Monday, June 27th. Watch for possible part day openings the week before.

Badges are sold at the pool during open hours. All residents entering the pool must have their own badge.

Chatham residents will need to present their drivers license as well as a current Jersey Central or Public Service utility bill with their Chatham address.

Badge guidelines will be posted and distributed at the pool.

Chatham resident "tentative" badge fees for the season are:

- \$375 Chatham Boro family of 4 or more
- \$100 Chatham Boro Individual
- \$50 Chatham Boro Senior Citizen
- \$475 Chatham Township family of 4 or more
- \$125 Chatham Township Individual
- \$75 Chatham Township Senior Citizen.

Swim lesson registration will be held at the pool. Chatham Borough children, interested in taking lessons, must be age 4 by June 1st to be eligible. Residents will need to present their child's original birth certificate at registration. Lesson details will be available at the pool as well as attendance guidelines for the lessons and for participation in the annual Water Lesson Carnival. The fee for lessons will be \$50. Lessons will begin the week of June 27th. The lessons run Monday through Friday for 3 consecutive weeks. Class sizes are limited.

Notices will be posted regarding adult water aerobic classes, water polo, raft days and other special events.
