Volunteers of all walks have always included community advocates among them: residents, merchants, seniors, private commercial property owners, and the local news media.


The Borough of Chatham is represented by a Borough Council liaison, and the Director of Community Affairs. Also participating are the representatives from the town's very active non-profit community organizations.
