The meeting minutes of the Board Health meeting held on October 9, 2014 were approved as amended.

Ms. DeRosa reported that the Ebola Presentation for First Responders in Madison recently was very well done.

Rabies Clinic Update

The veterinarian from Springfield NJ has agreed to work at the Board's Annual Rabies Clinic in January. Ms. Trotman will find out who brings the tags for the animals. Ms. DeRosa asked Board members to arrive 15 minutes earlier than the Clinic's opening.

Ms. Trotman's Report

Ms. Trotman reported that the dog situation on Chatham Street has been resolved. Also, no rats have been seen lately on Carmine Street.

Ms. Trotman also noted that St. Patrick's School has changed its food purveyor to be the Pascarella Brothers, on Watchung Ave.

Regarding Noah's Bagels on CVS Plaza, Ms. Trotman questioned what code she should use to enforce the absence of hot water violation.

Re-visiting a topic from last month's meeting, Board members discussed the step-edging for safer conditions on the Library's stairs. Perhaps this could be a future Eagle Scout Project.

Ms. DeRosa volunteered to pick up the No Smoking Educational material for the second graders.

Ms. DeRosa also offered to arrive early at the Rabies Clinic with all the necessary forms. Ms. Trotman will work on the tag situation with the veterinarian. Ms. Trotman said she would order 150 tags. The Clinic can run for two hours.

At 7:20 p.m. the meeting adjourned.
