

## **BECOME AN ELECTION DAY POLL WORKER**

Morris County election officials and the Chatham Borough Clerk's office are looking for registered voters who are interested in working at the polls in Chatham Borough on election days. Poll workers earn \$200 for each election day worked. Training classes will be conducted in October. Once an individual has completed training, he or she will be assigned to work the polls.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

1. Must be a registered voter in Morris County
2. Must be able to read and write English
3. Must be able to work a full day. No half day schedules

### **TRAINING REQUIREMENTS**

New Poll Workers are required by NJ election law to attend a two-hour training class presented by the Morris County Board of Elections, and all Poll Workers must attend a refresher training class at least once every two years to keep updated on new laws.

### **HOURS AND RATE OF PAY**

Report to your assigned polling place at 5:15am on Election Day; Polls close at 8:00pm. Poll Workers earn \$200 for the day.

### **Additional Pay**

A Poll Worker who picks up the election books and supplies from the Borough Clerk's office to the polling place will earn an additional \$12.50. Returning the election books and supplies back to the Borough Clerk's office at the close of polls will earn an additional \$12.50.
