Dear Chatham Borough Train Commuter:

In anticipation of a possible New Jersey Transit Rail strike, the Borough of Chatham has been working on a contingency plan to offer bus transportation to and from New York City starting Monday, March 14, 2016.

The current plan is to run three buses weekdays only (holiday excluded) starting at 5:30 a.m. from the Chatham Borough Train Station parking lot. Buses will leave when full. Drop-off in New York City would be on 8th Avenue between 31st and 33rd Streets. Pick-up will most likely be at the same location starting at 4:30 p.m.

The round-trip cost will be \$25.00 per day (cash only) which covers the cost of the bus rental. Tickets will be sold on a daily first-come, first-served basis by Borough personnel on site at the Train Station. There may be long delays and it is possible buses may not be allowed to enter New York City.

Hopefully, the labor issues will be resolved and train service will continue uninterrupted.
