pursuant to Chapter 3 of the Code of the Borough of Chatham entitled “Appointed
Positions Registry”**

- Please submit one application per board or commission or committee for which you are applying. The application will be kept on file for two years.
- An electronic signature is acceptable for the purpose of deeming the application complete.
- The Municipal Clerk will respond and acknowledge receipt of the Application Form on or before seven (7) days after the receipt of the Application Form.
- The Ordinance Application Form, as well as the Registry of all positions and terms, will be placed prominently on the Chatham Borough website:
www.chathamborough.org.
- Borough of Chatham employees may not serve on Borough of Chatham boards or commissions except as specifically provided by the statute or regulation, or by the Municipal Code, or as required to perform official duties.

In accordance with the Local Government Ethics Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:9-22.1 et. seq) annual Financial Disclosure Statements must be filed by elected officials, certain government employees, and members of the recreation commission, planning board, zoning board, board of health, environmental commission, historic preservation commission, shade tree commission, library board of trustees, and any other local governmental unit required by law to file an annual Financial Disclosure Statement.

The Borough will also post the Internet address for the downloadable, fill-in version of the “Local Government Ethics Law Financial Disclosure Statement,” which is www.nj.gov/dca/lgs, under “Ethics Law and Complaints,” on its web address, www.chathamborough.org, in the same Menu area as other web postings required pursuant to Chapter 3. Until permitted by the State of New Jersey, an e-mail signature is not acceptable for the purpose of deeming the Financial Disclosure Statement complete.
