Our Chatham Borough Health Officer was notified of two (2) additional residents that have tested positive (April 28 – May 5) for the COVID-19 virus for a total of fifty-four (54*) positive cases and one (1) additional death for a total of six (6) Covid-19 related deaths.

Chatham Borough Mayor Thaddeus Kobylarz and the Borough Council extend their deepest, heartfelt sympathy and condolences to the family during this very sad time. May God rest this soul as we stand in solidarity again and prayer in mourning this painful loss.

For patient confidentiality purposes, specific details will not be released. As is standard protocol, our health department is monitoring and investigating the cases including contact tracing and notifying appropriate parties. Self-quarantining protocols are in place.

As a reminder, residents should be, (including children) continuing our own social distancing and other guidelines to minimize community spread. We will continue to share information on this and other cases when appropriate.
