Chatham Borough Health Officer reported that two (2) residents have tested positive (September 25-30) for the COVID-19 virus for a total of ninety-five (95) positive cases. These numbers include one teenager and one resident over 20 years old.

As a reminder, residents (including children) should be, wearing masks, washing hands often and continuing to social distance as much as possible to minimize community spread. We will continue to share information on this and other cases when appropriate.
