I further understand that nothing herein shall be construed to waive or otherwise relinquish any claim, defense, or immunity available to Borough Officials and Agencies pursuant to law, including but not limited to those claims, defenses and immunities set forth in the New Jersey Tort Claims Act, N.J.S.A. 59:1-1 et seq. with respect to my participation in the 2018 Fishawack Festival.

Insurance Coverage Requirements

The Borough of Chatham and the Department of Community Services and Fishawack Event Organizers; 54 Fairmount Avenue, Chatham NJ 07928; must be named as additional insured in respect to the Fishawack Celebration and stay in effect for June 9, 2018 on your insurance policies, with minimum coverage as follows:

Certificate of insurance from contractor to include the following information:

- General liability limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage with at least \$2,000,000 general aggregate. Contractual liability must be included.
- Automobile liability limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage with no aggregate.
- Workers Compensation at Statutory limits
- Employers Liability at minimum limits of \$500,000.
- Umbrella liability limits of \$4,000,000 are strongly recommended, sitting excess of the General Liability, Automobile Liability and Employers Liability coverages.
- The member entity and any associations, recreations or committees formed by the member entity to organize the "event" must be named as additional insureds on the General Liability, Automobile Liability and Umbrella Liability coverages.
- Rain date, if applicable, should also be shown on the description section of the certificate of insurance.

Certificate(s) of Insurance must be received by May 14, 2018.

Insurance must remain in force for the duration of the 2018 Fishawack Festival activities and the certificate must reflect effective insurance coverage for the appropriate appearance times.
