ORDINANCE 20-11

CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHATHAM, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS AND ACQUISITIONS IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH, APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$56,000 AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM GENERAL CAPITAL FUND BALANCE OF THE BOROUGH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Chatham, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Chatham, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to make the following improvements and acquisitions in, by and for the Borough: (A) acquisition of furniture, tables and equipment and replacement of pumps at the Borough Pool; (B) installation of community gateway signs; (C) undertaking of improvements to various public buildings; (D) acquisition of various vehicle maintenance tools and equipment, a sewer line tracer locator kit and computer equipment for the use of the Department of Public Works; and (E) acquisition of computer equipment for the use of the Police Department. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$56,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from General Capital Fund Balance of the

Borough. The sum of \$56,000 is hereby appropriated from General Capital Fund Balance of the Borough to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. Said improvements are lawful capital improvements of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefitted.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
