**WHEREAS**, providing an opportunity for employees to elect to participate in Flexible Spending Accounts for Medical Expense Reimbursement and Dependent Care Expense Reimbursement and have their contributions deducted pre-tax through payroll hereby saving immediate Federal and FICA taxes; and

WHEREAS, Aflac Benefit Services provides a discounted fee schedule for Section 125 Premium Only Plan and Flexible Spending Account services at no final employer cost after employer matching FICA payroll tax savings with sufficient employee participation as a value added benefit to offering Aflac supplemental insurance benefits and education services to employees on a voluntary basis at no employer cost; and
