RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A 2016 SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE MADISON AREA YMCA, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$28,122.36

WHEREAS, the Borough of Chatham desires to engage the Madison Area YMCA ("YMCA") to provide certain cognitive behavioral counseling services to children and teens attending Chatham schools and/or living in Chatham Borough and their families ("Borough residents") for calendar year 2016; and

WHEREAS, the YMCA desires to render said cognitive behavioral counseling services to Borough residents as set forth in the Service Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the maximum contract amount shall not exceed \$28,122.36; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has confirmed that sufficient funds are available in the Project Community Pride Current Fund Account #6-01-25-240-298 for the award of this contract.

- **BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Council of the Borough of Chatham that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the 2016 Service Agreement with the Madison Area YMCA to provide cognitive behavioral counseling services to Borough residents as set forth in the Agreement, and in the amount not to exceed \$28,122.36; and

RESOLUTION #16-231

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE GRANT APPLICATION FOR GRANT YEAR JULY 2016 – JUNE 2017

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government, schools, law enforcement, non-profit organizations and the faith community in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse in communities throughout New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Chatham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey recognizes that the abuse of alcohol and drugs is a serious problem across all communities in our society and amongst people of all ages; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Chatham and the Township of Chatham have combined efforts and established the Municipal Alliance Committee of the Chathams; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Alliance Committee of the Chathams was approved for Municipal Alliance grant funding for Grant Year July 2016 – June 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse has agreed to make a \$20,073.00 grant funding allocation available to the Municipal Alliance Committee of the Chathams for Grant Year July 2016 – June 2017, contingent upon the Municipal Alliance Committee of the Chathams contributing a 25% Cash Match (\$5,018.25) and a 75% In-Kind Match (\$15,054.75) for a Total Alliance Budget of \$40,146.00; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Chatham and Township of Chatham will equally contribute the Cash Match and In-Kind Match required for the grant funding.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Chatham that Melicks Town Farm Inc. is hereby granted permission to provide free samples of its wine products to the public at the Chatham Borough Farmers' Market and to sell those products in original containers for off-premises consumption on the herein referenced date and time and as provided on the Special Wine Festival Permit issued by the New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control contingent upon the Borough Clerk verifying that a Special Wine Festival Permit has been issued for those dates and times; and
