Notes:

- *Currently everyone pays an annual solid waste bill plus pays for green bags. This approach is being discontinued, but column A shows what that would look like if it hadn't changed.*
- *Under this approach, 2023 solid wastes bill is \$374, but would go up to \$392 if we continued green bags. Solid waste fee covers recycling, mulch site, recycling center, etc.*
- *Now the solid waste bill will cover ALL solid waste costs – recycling, garbage collection, disposal, bulk, etc. and no green bags will be required*
- *May move to quarterly billing (1 bill for water + sewer + solid waste) and allow people to up/downsize quarterly (TBD)*
