Our Chatham Borough Health Officer was notified of two (2) additional resident that has tested positive (May 30 – June 4) for the COVID-19 virus for a total of fifty-nine (59) positive cases. During the period June 5 – June 18 there have been 0 positive cases.

During the period May 30 – June 4 there was one (1) death for a total of nine (9) Covid-19 related deaths. During the period June 5 – June 18 there have been 0 deaths.

Chatham Borough Mayor Thaddeus Kobylarz and the Borough Council extend their deepest, heartfelt sympathy and condolences to the family during this very sad time. May God rest this soul as we stand in solidarity again and prayer in mourning this painful loss.
